Incorporated in December 1986, the Dodge Brothers Club is a non-profit corporation with elected officers who volunteer their services as directors, editors, technical advisors, and members of special-project committees.

Currently, the Dodge Brothers Club membership spans the United States and Canada, with overseas members in Australia, Great Britain, New Zealand, Netherlands, Norway, Slovakia, Israel, and Uruguay. While most members own a DB or GB motor vehicle, ownership is not a prerequisite for membership. Some members are merely interested in the history of the Brothers, the history of their company, or are admirers of their vehicles. Annual membership dues are \$50, payable in U.S. funds only, drawn on a U.S.-owned bank, international postal order, U.S. money order, or U.S. Currency. New members may apply for a 6-month membership for \$25.
